Summary:

Churchill Stateside Group, LLC is seeking to hire a Renewable Energy Asset Manager located in Clearwater, FL. This position will be responsible for management of all commercial, contractual, regulatory and reporting obligations of a portfolio of Churchill Stateside Group, LLC large scale solar photovoltaic (PV) and storage plants in the commercial and power plant market segments. The position will work closely with key internal and external stakeholders to manage the long-term financial performance of their assigned assets with the goal of maximizing return on investment for the various project level investors. Specific responsibilities will include:

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Monitoring of project level profit & loss (P&L) activities to ensure that the projects are delivering expected financial returns
- Administering all project level agreements including review of consent requests and delivery of recommendations to senior management and investors, enforcement of reporting requirements with Managing Members and reconciliation of fees accrued
- Overseeing compliance of all project-level contracts including the PPA, O&M, EPC and financing agreements
- Managing relationships with key project level stakeholders including Managing Members, Upper Tier Investors and Consultants
- Supports cross-functional teams in resolution of material issues affecting assigned assets (e.g. commercial disputes, warranty claims, environmental or regulatory violations and tax matters)
- Monitoring PV and storage plant operational performance by working closely with the operations teams to identify and prioritize improvement initiatives being implemented as well as ensure significant offline events are remedied in a timely fashion
- Overseeing project level compliance to ensure that all filings and reports are completed accurately and on-time
- Ensuring the management framework developed by the Asset Management team is implemented consistently across all projects in assigned portfolio
- Developing market knowledge with goal of serving as the internal subject matter expert in the structure of the electricity markets in which the power plants are located

- Identifying and executing on opportunities to generate incremental value from existing assets for Churchill Stateside Group, LLC and asset owners
